

ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION FOR APPROPRIATIONS AND TAX RATE

Ordinance Number: WRT 2013-01

Be it ordained by the **White River Township Board** that for the expenses of **WHITE RIVER TOWNSHIP, Johnson County** for the year ending December 31, **2014** the sums herein specified are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the several funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same. Such sums herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year, unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided for by law.
